Rosso Maremma Toscana 2008– *Tuscany, Italy*

Tuscany's tanic Sangiovese grape balanced with Merlot and Syrah. Big, bold, fruit driven, full bodied red wine blend with a nice oak character and nice tannin balance and dry finish. Great with food, especially the Lamb Shank.

TORREMORON 7.50 28

Tempranillo 2008– *Ribera del Duero, Spain*

100% Tempranillo. Nose of dark fruit and earth. On the palate it is well balanced with notes of, leather, jam, & youthful fruit. Tannins are smooth and elegant; the wine's finish is long and delicious.

HISTOIRE 9.50 32

Cabernet Sauvignon 2007– *Mendocino County, CA*

Rich, fruit driven, slightly dry, traditional cabernet. Rich, dark fruits, mild tannins, slight smoke. Excellent choice with red wine sauces such as the Beef Medallions.

FESTIVO 7.50 28

Malbec 2009– *Mendoza, Argentina*

Primary aromas of blackberry and black plum, with similar, intense fruit flavors on the palate, but a light summer Malbec showing cherry and plum. Polished, moderate tannins add structure and make this an ideal partner for many different dishes. Chicken,, grilled steak,, pan-seared tuna, and heartier vegetarian dishes all make terrific pairings. It also works beautifully as a casual sipper without food.

Chenin Blanc Steen Op Hout 2009– *South Africa*

Crisp citrus, luscious tropical fruit with a slightly dry note. A clean, lively wine with nuances of nutmeg and cloves. Well-balanced and elegant, but with weight and a powerful follow-through on the palate. Stylistically off-dry and lightly oaked this is an excellent food wine. Pairs beautifully with the mussels and cheese board.

Riesling Piesporter Michelsberg 2009- Germany
Dry, food-friendly Riesling with nice balance of natural sweetness and acidity.

KOTARE 7.50 28
Sauvignon Blanc 2010- Marlborough, New Zealand
A light bodied, dry, crisp wine that is bright and open-textured, with real transparency to the grapefruit, lime, green papaya and a hint of mineral as the finish lingers easily. Firm mouth-watering acidity is balanced by a full elegant palate.
